We will host **two designated Specialties** during this four-day cluster on **Saturday, March 20, and Sunday, March 21, 2010** in an exciting **new venue**, in the beautiful historic community of **Independence, Missouri**, a suburb of Kansas City.

If you enjoy history, there is plenty to see while visiting Independence! Independence, Missouri is known as the “Queen City of the Trails.” It was the starting place of the Santa Fe, Oregon and California trails. In the mid-1800’s more than 400,000 immigrants traveled the trails to find adventure out west. President Harry S. Truman called Independence home, and today the city is the home of his former residence, as well as his Presidential Library.



Blaze the trails –now the Interstate Highway system–to Independence, Missouri, and join us in celebrating our inaugural year at the new **Independence Events Center**. This venue should prove to be one of the most beautiful facilities in the Midwest in which to host a dog show. HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS



The Heart of America Samoyed Club has blocked rooms at a “dog friendly” hotel the second exit east of the show site, the **Hampton Inn Kansas City/Blue Springs, 900 NW South Outer Road, Blue Springs, MO, (816) 220-3844**. To make your reservation, please call the hotel directly, and ask for the “HOA Sammie Club room block.”

The Hampton Inn is located approximately 3 miles from the show site, and the nice folks there have set aside a variety of different room accommodations for our exhibitors. The Show Chair has negotiated a **special show rate of \$69/night, with no dog room fees**. This rate includes a great hot breakfast buffet daily.

The Hampton Inn has good grassy areas for walking the dogs. It is also next door to a Vet Clinic, who has outside poop bags and disposal already set up.

The other hotel we would recommend is **Comfort Suites**, that is located just about two or three blocks from the show site. The AKC rate is \$94/night, and no pet fees. Each room is a King suite, so, there is a separate living room and bedroom, with a kitchen.

There are several hotels that are cheaper that are also available, but none of them have the great combination of amenities that are available at the Hampton Inn. 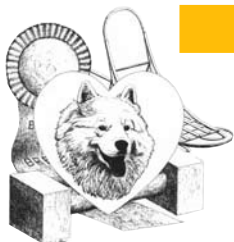
